Key Policy Areas:

Support & Inclusion:

- **Inclusion:** Framework ensures students with disabilities receive necessary accommodations.

Standards & Achievement:

- **High Expectations:** Policies aim for top-tier education, fostering innovation, critical thinking and skills.
- **Curriculum:** Focus on aligned learning outcomes, spiral curriculum, and rigorous assessments.

Conduct & Wellbeing:
